## PRESS RELEASE

The New York State Board of Law Examiners announced today that grading has been completed for the July 2024 New York State Bar Examination. The examination results were posted today to candidate accounts in the Applicant Services Portal.

The Board examined 10,392 candidates, including U.S. domestic-educated candidates and foreign-educated candidates, first-time and repeat takers, during the July 2024 bar examination. Of those candidates, 7,158 passed for an overall passing rate of 69%, an increase of 3% from last year and the highest overall passing rate on a July exam since 2013.

The passing rate for the 6,093 Juris Doctor graduates of American Bar Association accredited law schools who took the bar examination for the first time in July 2024 is 88%, an increase of 3% from last year and the highest passing rate for this cohort on a July exam since 2009. The passing rate for the 3,486 Juris Doctor graduates of the New York law schools who took the examination for the first time is 87%, an increase of 4% from last year and the highest passing rate for this group on a July exam since 2013. The passing rate for the 2,607 Juris Doctor graduates of out-of-state ABA-accredited law schools who took the examination for the first time is 90%, an increase of 2% from last year and the highest passing rate for this cohort on a July exam since 2008.

The passing rate for the 2,073 repeat takers of the bar examination in July 2024 is 27%, a decrease of 2% from last year. Repeat takers accounted for 20% of all candidates who sat for the July 2024 examination. Foreign-educated candidates, totaling 3,429 or 33% of all candidates, had a passing rate of 45%, the same passing rate as last year.

Passing rates for various groups of candidates are presented on the chart below.

A list of candidates who passed the July 2024 bar examination will be available to the public on the Board's website at [www.nybarexam.org](http://www.nybarexam.org) after 10:00 AM ET on Thursday, October 24, 2024. Each successful candidate, who also has completed the New York Law Course and taken and passed both the New York Law Exam and the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination as required by the Rules of the New York State Court of Appeals, will be certified by the Board to the Appellate Division for admission to the bar. Each candidate must then appear before the Committee on Character and Fitness to be examined as to their character and fitness before being admitted to the bar.

The Board congratulates the candidates who were successful on the July 2024 bar examination.
